Relationship data are not collected for victims of offenses reported with an Unknown Offender or of other Crimes Against Property or Crimes Against Society offenses.

²Victims were related to all offenders, whether one or more, of the reported offense.

³Victims were related to at least one of the multiple offenders of the reported offense.

⁴Victims knew, but were not related to, one or more of the multiple offenders of the reported offense.

⁵Victims were mutual combatants (victim was offender) or had an unknown relationship with a single offender. In the case of multiple offenders, victims' relationships were combinations of strangers, mutual combatants, and/or unknown offenders.
