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LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL DATA

The Texas Uniform Crime Reporting program collects pertinent data relating to the police agencies of the state through the Law Enforcement Employee (LEE) Survey. This survey measures law enforcement employee strength, employment trends and the number of law enforcement officers assaulted or killed in the line of duty. In 2018, 499 Texas law enforcement agencies responded to the LEE Survey.

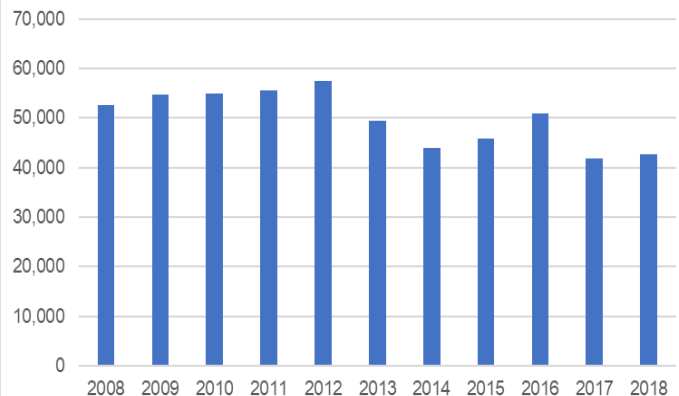
Commissioned Personnel

The LEE Survey reported that the responsive agencies employed 42,759 full-time sworn officers as of October 31, 2018. The average number of officers for every 1,000 inhabitants of Texas was 1.5. The ratio of law enforcement officers to inhabitants increased 0.6% from 2017.

Civilian Employees

Responsive agencies reported that they employed 23,974 civilian workers. This is a decrease of 7.9% and comprises 35.9% of the Texas law enforcement work force.

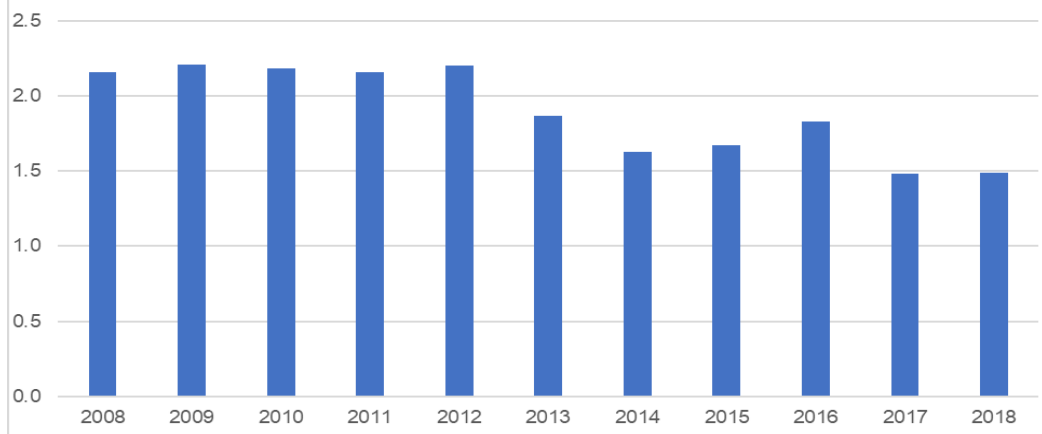
Law Enforcement Officers

Per 1,000 Population 2008-2018

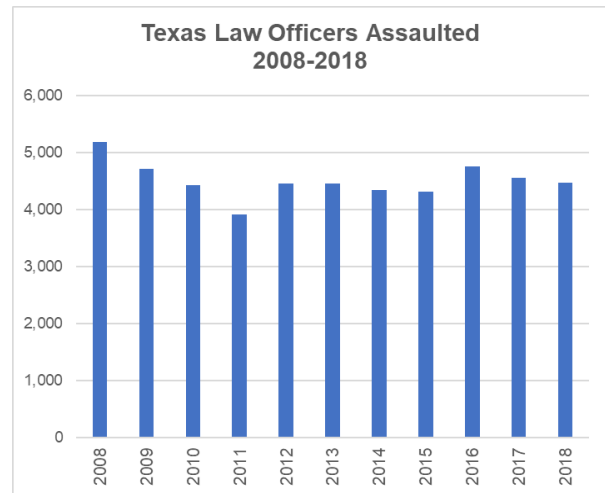
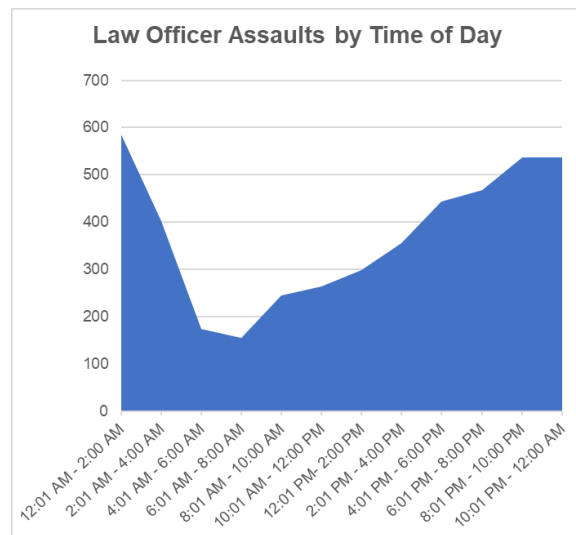


LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ASSAULTED

The death or assault of a law enforcement officer seriously impacts the feeling of security in society. As the possibility of being assaulted may discourage persons from considering law enforcement careers, attacks on police officers reduce their ability to combat crime. As such, violence towards police equals violence towards society.

In 2018, 4,617 Texas Law Enforcement Officers were assaulted in the line of duty. The number of officers assaulted increased 1.4% from the number of assaults in 2017. Assaults resulted in injury to the officer in 43.7% of the cases and 85.9% of the assaults were cleared².

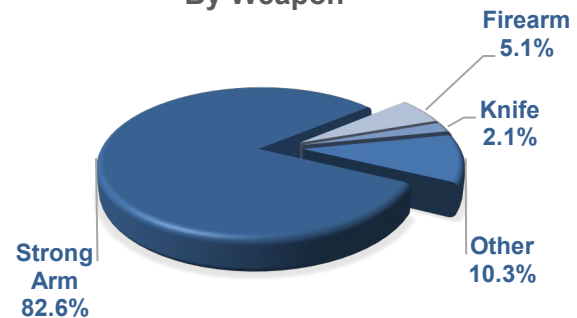

FELONIOUS DEATHS

During 2018, three Texas Law Officers were killed in the line of duty by criminal action:

- ◆ Officer **David Charles Sherrard**, Richardson PD, February 7, 2018 – Gunfire
- ◆ Officer **Rogelio Santander, Jr.**, Dallas PD, April 25, 2018 – Gunfire
- ◆ Corporal **Garrett Willis Hull**, Fort Worth PD, September 14, 2018 – Gunfire
